次の英文は英会話の授業の補習で、朋樹 (Tomoki) と山田先生 (Mr. Yamada) がベトナム (Vietnam) に住んでいる Nguyen (グエン) とオンラインを活用して会話をしている場面である。これを読んで、後の各問に答えなさい。

- Mr. Yamada : Long time no see, Nguyen. Today, we are going to talk about unique sports. Tomoki, can you please start?
- Tomoki : OK. When it's winter in Japan, people in snowy places like to play a sport called "snowball fighting". People make snowballs and then throw them at their opponents.
- Nguyen : No. Because we have little snow in Vietnam. But it really looks like fun. I want to know more about the sport snowball fighting.
- Tomoki : All right. Each team has seven players. They use ninety snowballs prepared beforehand. A team wins a set when the players hit all of their opponents or capture the opponent's flag behind the court.
- Nguyen : It really looks like fun. ① But I think (to / difficult / make / it / making) so many snowballs.
- Tomoki : Yes, it is not easy. Now, can you tell us about sports in Vietnam?
- Nguyen : Sure. We like to play "Da Cau."
- Tomoki : Da Cau? What kind of sport is that?

- Tomoki : Then, what do you use to hit it with? Do you mean you kick the shuttlecock?
- Nguyen : Yes, that's right. Da Cau has another name, "Shuttlecock Kicking." To tell you the truth, I play Da Cau every weekend at school. Our team had a big match last month. Now I'd like to show you a video of it.
- Tomoki : Wow! ② They (very / best / at / good / are) kicking the shuttlecock. Also I've found that the shuttlecocks are a little different from badminton ones. I'd like to play it because I love soccer.
- Nguyen : Tomoki, I have a question about the sport snowball fighting. When and why was it started in Japan?
- Tomoki : Oh sorry, but I don't know much about those things. How about Da Cau in Vietnam?
- Nguyen : There are several ideas about its roots. One of them is that many hundreds of years ago the people in a small village started playing it at a local festival. During the festival, they had a tradition of everyone playing together from young kids to adults.

- Mr. Yamada : Great. It's time to finish. Tomoki, you should keep his questions in mind. Thank you, Nguyen.

4 次の英文は、健 (Ken) が、いくつかの国における1日の一人あたりの野菜の平均摂取量について、インターネットで調べて表 (Table) とグラフ (Graph) を作り、英語の授業の時間に発表したときのものである。これを読んで、後の各問に答えなさい。

Last week, my mother taught me that we should eat 350 grams of vegetables a day because our body needs them. I didn't know that I ate so many vegetables every day. So, I used the Internet to find out how many grams of vegetables people in Japan and also people in other countries eat each day on average per person.

First, look at this table. It shows how many grams of vegetables people in five different countries ate per day on average in 2007. Japanese people ate more vegetables than people in Australia and India. But people in America and Korea ate more than Japanese people. I was surprised to find that Japanese people ate only about a half the amount of vegetables that people in Korea ate.

I was especially interested in America, because I thought that people there didn't eat so many vegetables. This is why I made this graph to show how many grams of vegetables one American person and one Japanese person ate a day on average from 1987 through 2007. In 1987, Japanese ate more vegetables than American people, but ten years later Americans ate much more vegetables than Japanese people.

After making this graph, I asked myself, "Why did the grams of vegetables American people ate change so much from 1992 to 2002?" And then, I found on the Internet a movement called '5-a-day'. The movement started in America, and became popular in 1991. The term '5-a-day' means "Let's eat five dishes of vegetables every day." I think this movement worked well in America.

So, why don't we learn about '5-a-day' and eat more vegetables?

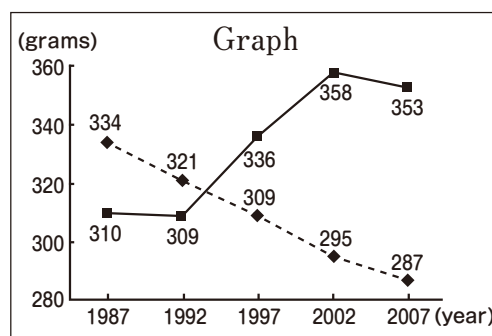
